VILLAGE OF KASLO BYLAW NO. 2001

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT CERTAIN ANIMALS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF KASLO

WHEREAS it is provided by section 8(3)(k) of the Community Charter that a Council may, by bylaw, regulate, prohibit and impose requirements in relation to animals;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Kaslo considers that it is prudent and necessary to prohibit certain animals from being kept within the Village of Kaslo;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Kaslo, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Village of Kaslo Animal Prohibition Bylaw No. 2001"
- 2. No person shall own, keep or harbour any prohibited animal within the boundaries of the Village of Kaslo which is included in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this Bylaw.
- 3. A person who, on the date of adoption of this bylaw may continue to keep that prohibited animal under the following conditions until the prohibited animal has died or has otherwise been disposed of:
 - (a) The prohibited animal is kept secure at the owner's premises, except for visits to a veterinarian's office.
 - (b) The prohibited animal is kept from reproducing.
 - (c) The owner has available for inspection a signed and notarized statement by at least three witnesses stating that the prohibited animal was witnessed to be in the possession of the stated owner and kept within the boundaries of the Village of Kaslo on the date of adoption of this bylaw.
- 4. A Person who contravenes this Bylaw commits an offence and is punishable in accordance with the Offence Act.
- 5. This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon adoption.

READ A THIRD TIME the 24th day of August, 2010.
